

Rules of the Game

- ✓ Team on the top line will throw first.

Points

Bag in-the-hole: 3pts - bag thrown or otherwise moved completely through the platform hole.

Bag in-the-count: 1pt - bag that lands with any portion of the corn bag resting on the cornhole platform. It must not touch the ground or any portion of the court prior to coming to rest on platform. If this happens, bag is foul and must be removed from play before the next bag is thrown.

- ✓ Play continues with these points until a team has 21 or more points

Scoring

Cancellation scoring: corn bags in-the-hole and corn bags in-the-count cancel each other out.

Only non-cancelled corn bags are counted in the score for the inning.

Bags in-the-hole: Any non-cancelled bags will count as 3 points

Bags in-the-count: Any non-cancelled bags will count as 1 point

- ✓ Bags on-the-count may be knocked off the platform or in-the-hole by an opponent or by the contestants other corn bags. Where the corn bag ultimately lands determines the points.

Example of scoring: Team A throws 2 bags in-the-hole and 1 in-the-count

Team B throws 1 bag in-the-hole and 2 in-the-count

Team A would get 3 points for the non-cancelled bag in-the-hole

Team B would get 1 point for the non-cancelled bag in-the-count

Innings

Each cornhole match is broken down into innings of play. Top of the inning and bottom.

Top: when both contestants pitching from the first platform (which is marked) pitch all 4 bags

Bottom: when remaining contestants from second platform pitch all 4 bags

- ✓ The winner of the inning will pitch first (in marked spot) in the next inning

Length of Game

- ✓ Each match will be played until the first team reaches (or exceeds) **21** after completed inning.
- ✓ The winning team does not have to win by 2 points.
- ✓ If tied at 21 (or more) must play another complete inning to win.
- ✓ Match can never end during the middle of an inning. If first pitching team reaches 21 points, game is not over until the other side (or second players) are allowed to pitch all of their corn bags and the inning is completed

Leah's Ladies MS Bean Bag Toss Tournament Policy

The following information is for any person desiring to participate in the Leah's Ladies MS Bean Bag Toss tournament and must be aware of prior to entering and/or participating. It is the responsibility of each participant to know the rules and policies. This bean bag toss tournament was started to raise money for the MS Society as a fun and friendly competition.

Tournament Format

The tournament consists of a preliminary Group Play bracket and a Championship bracket.

Group Play: The tournament starts with Group Play. Group play is a double elimination bracket with 8 teams. Teams compete until there are two teams remaining. Groups are selected at random and each match is a single game. The bracket provided at each set of boards is labelled to indicate both the order of the games (Game 1, Game 2, etc.) and the position on the bracket teams will be placed depending on the outcome of a game. Example: Loser of game 1 writes their name next to "L1" on the bottom part of the bracket. The Group Winner, Runner-up, 3rd place & 4th place from each group advance into a single elimination bracket to determine 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place overall finishers.

Championship Bracket: Matches are best 2 out of 3 games. Once a team loses a match, they are eliminated (The two teams who lose in the semifinal will play for 3rd place).

Tournament Eligibility

Must register prior to the registration deadline to be eligible to play in the tournament. Switching partners once play has started is prohibited. Starting the tournament with a different partner than registered with is allowed. Players must be 18 or older.

Conditions of Competition

The tournament will take place rain or shine.

Conduct Policy

Treat all players, volunteers and The Vines property with respect. Being disrespectful can be terms for disqualification and you may be asked to leave the property. Drinking of alcohol allowed for those 21 years and older.

Equipment

All players must use the provided equipment: boards and bags. If you use other equipment than provided you will be disqualified.

Scoring

Teams score on their own, following the scoring from the American Cornhole Association. Please see the separate Rules of the Game document with complete scoring rules.

Pace of Play

Keep the pace of play moving to help with the flow of the tournament.

Cancellation

Please do your best to cancel 72 hours before tournament day. All money is donated to the MS Society, so refunds will not be issued.
